


ABOUT

VA Campus Building 208 is a 53-unit apartment building for Veteran's experiencing homelessness. It includes fully furnished studio and one-bedroom units ranging from 315 to 709 square feet, including units for persons with mobility, aural, or visual disabilities.

Located on the beautiful West VA Campus, on-site amenities include indoor and outdoor community areas, bocce ball courts, laundry facilities, SmartTV, and paid WiFi and utilities.



HOW TO APPLY

Referrals to VA Campus Building 208 require prospective applicants to be HUD/VASH eligible and to be registered in the Los Angeles Coordinated Entry System (CES). Referrals may be made via Veterans' existing HUD/VASH Case Managers or through the West LA VA Welcome Center at Building 257 within the West LA VA North Campus located at 11301 Wilshire Blvd, Los Angeles, CA 90049. ACCESSIBLE APARTMENTS

Nine (9) of the fifty-three (53) units meet ADA requirements for accessibility: six (6) for individuals experiencing mobility issues and three (3) with special communication features for those with vision or hearing impairments.

PARKING

Parking is limited and will be assigned on a first come, first served basis.
